

Criteria for Annual Maritime Scholarship

The Maritime Authority of the Cayman Islands (also known as Cayman Maritime) in conjunction with the Ministry of Education is accepting applications from Caymanians wishing to undertake a programme of study to pursue a career in the maritime industry. Consideration will be given to pursue an under-graduate, post-graduate or professional qualification in the following disciplines:

- ▶ naval architecture
- ▶ marine engineering
- ▶ marine surveying
- ▶ maritime administration
- ▶ nautical studies

Consideration will also be given in areas such as: specialist maritime legal services, human resource management, accounting, information technology, and other areas in support of the maritime sector.

Applicants must **at minimum**:

- ▶ Possess the Right to be Caymanian;
- ▶ Provide proof of having been domiciled in the Cayman Islands for five years prior to application;
- ▶ Be 18 or older (may be varied at Council's discretion);
- ▶ Provide proof of acceptance at a competitively ranked institution;
- ▶ Have a genuine interest in the maritime industry;
- ▶ Possess good interpersonal and communication skills, work ethics and character;
- ▶ Be committed to contributing to the development of the local maritime industry through implementing new skills and knowledge acquired; and
- ▶ Possess the personal qualities to benefit from their scholarship and use it to succeed in the maritime industry.
- ▶ For Undergraduate Study: Possess 5 higher level 'O' Level passes, including Math & English or cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher PLUS any of the following:
 - 3 'A' Levels with a minimum grade of C in each 'A' Level
 - OR Associates degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
 - OR Advanced Placement minimum grade of 3 with three subjects
 - OR International Baccalaureate Diploma (3 Standard Level and 3 Higher Level Classes with no grade lower than a '4', plus completion of TOK, CAS, EE)

- OR 3 Higher Level (HL) International Baccalaureate Certificates with a minimum total of 13 points and no grade lower than a '4'
- OR 5 Standard Level (SL) International Baccalaureate Certificates with no grade lower than a '4'.

At the discretion of the Education Council:

You MAY qualify if you possess a minimum of 7 higher level 'O' Level subjects with 'A' & 'B' grades, including Math and English or a cumulative high school GPA of 3.25 or higher including Math and English, WITH any of the following:

- A minimum combined SAT score of 1700
 - OR a minimum ACT score of 30
- ▶ For Post-Graduate Study: Possess a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or an Upper Second Class Degree (2:1) or higher at the Bachelor's level to pursue a Master's Degree. Possess a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or an Upper Second Class Degree (2:1) or higher at the Master's level to pursue a PHD.

Application deadline: 31 January of each year.
